Sere Leber, being first duly sworn on oath deposes and says:

1. On February 18, 2020, I was working as a poll worker in the Town of Warren, St Croix County, Wisconsin.
2. I worked the afternoon shift along with John Kraft. John and I are both Republicans. The remaining poll workers, including Max Hansen, Doreen Kruschke, are Kathy Munkelwitz, and Deina Schirmer.
3. John Kraft and I sat at a table next to each other. Our task was to sign and issue ballots. Our table was 30 feet away from the greeting table where Max Hansen and Doreen Kruschke sat.
4. I admit that John and I had some general discussion about the Lincoln Day Dinner we had both recently attended, but not in the presence of voters. When voters entered the room there was no talking, no discussion of anything as per the election regulations and rules. We maintained silence. I may have spoken a bit louder due to John Kraft hearing disability.
5. Max Hansen and Doreen Kruschke accusation that I was talking when voters were present is false.
6. It is true that a gentleman voter returned to my table carrying his ballot. He started to ask me a question. I immediately shrugged my shoulders and put my hands up in the air to say I could not answer. The voter realized I could not answer him and he walked back to the voting booth to finish voting. I never said a word to him. Max Hansen who was sitting with Doreen Kruschke 30 feet away at the entrance/exit door, yelled out, "You can not do that!" To prevent the voter from being further embarrassed I said nothing and no further action was taken. John Kraft who sat next to me was also a witness to this incident and has given an affidavit on it. Mr. Kraft will mail to you in a separate envelope.

7. The accusation by Doreen and Max that I pointed to a specific spot on the ballot is false. I did not point to anything on this gentleman's ballot.

8. I ask the Wisconsin State Election Commission to inform Deina Shirmer she does not have the authority to remove me from the Town of Warren Election Official list.
