RE: Formal Complaint against handling of Absentee Ballots/General Election Complaint for Milwaukee, WI April 7, 2020 Spring Election

Dear Sir,

I am writing to file a formal complaint regarding the Absentee Ballot and General Election process for the City of Milwaukee April 7, 2020 Spring Election.

For the State of Wisconsin Supreme Court to hold a *virtual* vote to overturn Governor Evers decision and send voters *in person* to the polls was beyond comprehension. Tens of thousands of voters were unable to get to the polls due to the pandemic. It is unconscionable that our state leaders would hold their vote in the safety of their homes while sending us, who had requested but never received absentee ballots, to five polling stations to create a mass gathering which our highest-ranking city and state officials have banned.

In an effort to keep myself safe, I requested an Absentee Ballot from the City of Milwaukee. I have a printed confirmation, which is enclosed, which shows my Absentee Ballot request was received via the MyVote system. I printed the document on Wednesday, April 1, 2020 at 11:31am. The printout is proof I requested my ballot prior to the cutoff date and time of Thursday, April 2, 2020 at 5pm. I did NOT receive my requested ballot.


On April 7, 2020, I contacted the Wisconsin Election Commission at 608-266-8005 at 12:13pm today and was transferred to Richard. The purpose of my call was to file an official complaint because I have not received my Absentee Ballot. He said I had two options: 1) File an informal complaint on their website; and/or 2) File a formal complaint with the Commission


Per Wisconsin Election Statute 5.06.01 this letter is to serve as my formal complaint against the General Election and Absentee Ballot process for the State of Wisconsin, City of Milwaukee, April 7, 2020 Spring Election.

I feel strongly that this election is NOT a true depiction of the "voices of the people" as many people, for many reasons, were not able to vote their choice. If my voice wasn't heard in the vote, I want to be sure it's heard in protest of how this election was handled. I feel something criminal has taken place with this election.
