The Seventh Circuit Court of Appeals has denied a stay motion in the *One Wisconsin Institute* case, which means that the durational residency requirement for voter registration purposes is now 10 days.

For purposes of determining an individual's residency for voting, an individual need only reside in an election district or ward for 10 consecutive days before any election where the individual offers to vote to be eligible.
