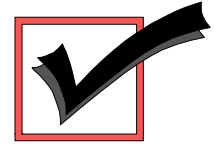


BALLOT ACCESS CHECKLIST FOR 2018 FEDERAL CANDIDATES IN WISCONSIN



Each of the following forms must be completed and filed on time by a candidate for federal office in order for the candidate's name to be placed on the ballot for the **August 14, 2018 Partisan Primary** and the **November 6, 2018 General Election** in Wisconsin.

- Campaign Finance Registration and Disclosure Requirements***

- Complete and Submit a Declaration of Candidacy (Form [EL-162](#))*** to the Wisconsin Elections Commission (WEC). The Declaration of Candidacy must be received in the WEC office no later than **5 p.m., on Friday, June 1, 2018**, or the candidate's name will not be placed on the ballot. If the form is faxed or emailed, the original document must follow, postmarked no later than June 1, 2018. Wis. Stat. §§ 8.15(4)(b), 8.21, 8.30(4), ch. EL § 6.04, Wis. Adm. Code.

- Circulate and Submit Nomination Papers for Partisan Office (Form [EL-168](#))*** to the Wisconsin Elections Commission (WEC). Original nomination papers (no photocopies, faxes or emailed documents) must be received in the WEC office no later than **5 p.m. on Friday, June 1, 2018** or the candidate's name will not be placed on the ballot. Nomination papers may not be circulated before April 15, 2018. Wis. Stat. §8.15(1), ch. EL § 6.04(2), Wis. Adm. Code.

The number of signatures required are as follows:
