EXECUTIVE ORDER #111

Relating to a Special Election for the Sixty-Ninth Assembly District

WHEREAS, the Honorable Scott Suder submitted his resignation as a State Representative for the Sixty-Ninth Assembly District, effective September 3, 2013.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to article IV, section 14 of the Wisconsin Constitution and section 8.50(4) of the Wisconsin Statutes, order that a special election be held on November 19, 2013 to fill the vacancy in the Sixty-Ninth Assembly District, as created in 2011 Act 43, and whose boundaries are set out in section 4.69 of the Wisconsin Statutes. A copy of the boundary descriptions may be obtained from the Government Accountability Board or the Legislative Reference Bureau. The term for the Sixty-Ninth Assembly District will expire on the first Monday in January, 2015. If a primary is necessary, it shall be held on October 22, 2013. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin today, September 4, 2013, and nomination papers must be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., September 24, 2013 in the office of the Government Accountability Board, 212 East Washington Avenue, Third Floor, Madison, Wisconsin, 53707. This election shall be held, conducted, canvassed, and returned in accordance with law.
